



## TO: ALL PJ'11 UNIT SCOUTERS

### 14 DAYS TO PJ!

Are you ready? Here are some important final notices and reminders.

#### Transportation - Arrivals

- Arrive at the transfer station organized and **ready to leave immediately** at your assigned time.
- Parents **cannot** send you off at the transfer station, due to congestion. They can park on the highway to wave goodbye.
- Units have been **assigned departure times**. If you arrive early, you must wait for your assigned departure time, as the ferry is completely booked for the day. The Transportation team will process all boardings with a swipe card, no tickets need to be issued.
- If you do not board the ferry at your assigned time, you will assume all costs.
- All camping gear must be loaded on the trucks provided. Personal day packs only to be carried on the ferry.
- Upon arrival at the Langdale ferry terminal, Units will be loaded on busses to Camp Byng. Expect to wait up to an hour. **Scouts are NOT to leave the designated "triangle"**, do not enter the terminal parking lot. Washrooms are provided.
- Units driving private vehicles to Camp Byng are responsible for the ferry costs. See vehicle access below.
- Units arriving at the **airport or Via Rail stations** have scheduled busses and trucks to meet you. Look for the orange shirted "HIT ME VESTED" transportation volunteers on **Level 2 Domestic**.

#### Transportation - Departures

- Departure trips are scheduled, those missing their scheduled bus will wait until 3:25 pm ferry
- Those Units departing for the airport and Via Rail must ensure that they load their gear onto the appropriate truck. If you load onto the wrong truck, all gear will be donated to the local clothing drive.

Mark your gear with the PJ luggage tags provided to you. Do not overload your patrol boxes. Boxes weighing 100 lbs or over will NOT be transported.

#### Vehicle access/Parking

There is **no vehicle access** to Camp Byng. All Units arriving by private vehicle from the ferry to PJ must park in the off-site parking lot. The off-site parking is on the left side of the highway as you are leaving Gibsons. It will be well marked.

We will shuttle the Unit members and gear to Camp.

No unloading on the roadside.

### **Program**

Review your Program handbook for your assigned programs and check for any specialized gear that you may be requested to bring ie: bike helmets, hiking boots.

### **Photo ID**

All Unit Scouters will be issued photo ID tags which must be worn at all times. If you have not already submitted your photo, do so immediately to [pj2011photos@hotmail.com](mailto:pj2011photos@hotmail.com). If you do not submit your photo, be prepared to wait at registration while we process your ID tag.

### **BRING WITH YOU**

**Forms – 3 hard copies** of each form for each member (Youth and Adults) of your Unit:

- PJ Food Form
- PJ Medical Form. Print the name of the member on page 2 and staple the 2 pages together.
- PJ Parent Consent form (for all members under 19 years of age)
- PJ Medication forms (only if applicable)

Please come prepared with **3 sets of complete paperwork in 3 envelopes** marked with your Unit number. 2 sets are for PJ staff, one set is for your records.
